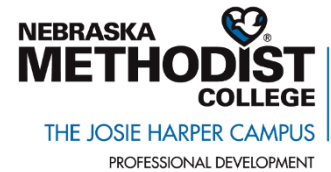

Track 1: Prevention for All Health Care Settings, Acute Care Hospital, Ambulatory Care & Surgical Centers

Track 2: Prevention for All Health Care Settings and Long-Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities

Program Details:

The Nebraska Infection Control Network (NICN) Primary Infection Prevention course offers a combination of lectures, discussions, and educational activities on the prevention and control of infections in various healthcare settings. The first day will focus on infection and prevention in all healthcare settings. Day two will focus on acute care hospitals, ambulatory care & surgical Centers, or, long-term care & assisted living facilities.

Primary Infection Prevention Track Two: Prevention for All Health Care Settings, *Long-Term Care, and Assisted Living Facilities*

All attendees receive the same content on day one. Track Two day two is geared toward the specific needs of long-term care and assisted living facilities. Learners who attend the full course (two days) have the option to obtain a Long-Term Care certificate of knowledge validation by taking a written post-test after the training. This certificate is issued by NICN in collaboration with Nebraska ICAP and Nebraska DHHS Epidemiology Unit, and it is valid for three years. The post-test will be administered after the Day Two Long-Term Care & Assisted Living session.

Dates/Times: Thursday, April 3, 2025, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, and Friday, April 4, 2025, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. If you choose to take the post-test, that starts at 4:00pm.

Value: \$600.00 Cost: \$300 with the option to purchase a printed copy of the presentation slides.
