Primary Infection Prevention Track Two: Prevention for All Health Care Settings,

Long-Term Care, and Assisted Living Facilities

Learners who attend the full course (two days) have the option to obtain a Long-Term Care certificate of knowledge validation by taking a written post-test after the training. This certificate is issued by NICN in collaboration with Nebraska ICAP and Nebraska DHHS Epidemiology Unit, and it is valid for three years. The post-test will be administered at the conclusion of day two Long-Term Care & Assisted Living session. There is no additional cost for this. There is no continuing education offered for this test. The test will start at 4:00 pm.
